Supervision & Safeguarding Policy

Commitment to Safeguarding

Cardiff Allstars FC is committed to providing a safe, positive, and supportive environment for all players. The welfare of children is our highest priority, and we ask all parents and guardians to support us in maintaining appropriate supervision at all times.

Under 16 Supervision Policy

1. All children under the age of 16 must have a parent or guardian present at special events (e.g. Christmas parties, presentations, tournaments, etc.).
2. If you are unable to attend a special event, please contact the coaches in advance. Where possible, we will work with you to help arrange appropriate supervision for your child during the event.
3. If you make a private arrangement with another parent or guardian to supervise your child in your absence, you must notify the coaches beforehand.

Under 12 Supervision Policy

1. All children under the age of 12 must have a parent or guardian present at all times. This applies to games, training sessions, and all club events.
2. If you make a private arrangement with another parent or guardian to supervise your child in your absence, you must notify the coaches beforehand.
3. Due to staffing numbers, coaches are unable to supervise children when leaving the premises. A parent or guardian must accompany their child at any time they wish to leave, including for bathroom use.

Safeguarding & Duty of Care

- The club operates in line with recognised safeguarding principles to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all children.
- Coaches are responsible for delivering football activities in a safe environment but are not responsible for primary supervision outside of training delivery unless explicitly agreed in advance.
- Parents and guardians remain responsible for their child's welfare before, during, and after sessions and events unless a formal arrangement has been communicated and agreed.
- Any safeguarding concerns should be reported immediately to a coach or the club's designated safeguarding lead.
- Failure to comply with supervision requirements may result in a child being unable to participate in sessions or events for safeguarding reasons.
